

CUBOREE

Two of the train cars are for sleeping and the 3rd car is for cooking and eating. The sleeping cars can only sleep up to 16 Cubs. If we have more Cubs wanting to attend we can set up tents outside. The theme for the Cuboree is “Voyageurs”. Lots of fun events planned. All of the food cooked for the Cuboree will be done by our Leaders of the 5th/13th Agincourt Cub Pack.

We will be leaving from Pauline Johnson P.S. at Friday May 25th at 6:45pm and returning on Sunday May 27th between 2:00 and 3:00pm. **We will be need parents able to drive Cubs to and from the camp. Leaders will be transporting all of the food, camping and cooking gear. If space is available, Leaders can carry some of the Cubs personal gear.**

We will not have time to check your child’s personal gear or equipment so please make sure your child has the appropriate changes of clothing, footwear and sleeping equipment for the weekend. Also your Leader must be made aware of any medication or food allergies. Health Cards are to be placed in your child’s uniform shirt pocket.


